

Boy Scout Troop 39 PARTICIPATION POLICY

Rank Advancement Participation and Leadership Policy (Star to Eagle)

Participation requirements for Star, Life & Eagle advancements are found in the official BSA web site www.scouting.org. The Troop 39 Committee has adopted the definition of “active in your troop”, in addition to regular attendance at weekly troop meetings, as attending half of the troop functions available for scout participation and will be assessed at each Board of Review for the individual scout. Should a scout have a specific and unique situation due to family, school, religious or other civic function conflicts, these will be addressed at each Board of Review setting. Leadership requirements are also identified in the official BSA web site www.scouting.org. The committee expects each scout to progress to successively higher levels of leadership as they advance in rank. If you are not selected by the troop/patrol membership for a leadership role (Sr. Patrol Leader or Patrol Leader), the Scoutmaster will assign you either another leadership role or a special leadership project for completion during the period you are working on a specific rank. These leadership roles will also be addressed at each Board of Review setting.
